WHERE EVERYONE BELONGS



FOUNDED IN 1946, CAMP CHATEAUGAY IS SET ON 250 ACRES OF PRISTINE ADIRONDACK LAKEFRONT IN NORTHERN NEW YORK. SURROUNDED BY FORESTS, WATER, AND OPEN SKIES, IT IS A PLACE WHERE GENERATIONS OF CAMPERS HAVE FOUND CONFIDENCE, CONNECTION, AND A SENSE OF HOME.

From the moment campers arrive, there is a feeling of familiarity. Camp Chateaugay is warm, grounded, and deeply human. Here, children are encouraged to be themselves, try new things and grow within a community that values kindness, safety, and belonging.



OUR CAMP COMMUNITY

We welcome campers ages 7 to 17 and accommodate up to 300 campers each summer. Campers are grouped thoughtfully by age and live in comfortable, home style cabins that foster connection, friendship, and security. Our program blends camper choice with carefully assigned activities, ensuring that every child has opportunities to explore their interests while being supported in discovering new ones.



STAFF & SUPERVISION

Our staff works closely with each camper, providing skilled instruction, thoughtful guidance, and consistent care. Camp Chateaugay maintains an excellent staff to camper ratio, and many senior staff and counsellors return year after year, creating continuity and trust. Extensive pre camp training and close attention to detail help ensure a safe, positive, and nurturing experience for every camper.



FACILITIES & ENVIRONMENT

We offer modern facilities while preserving the rustic charm of the Adirondacks. Our waterfront includes over a quarter mile of shoreline on a 14 mile lake, with designated areas for swimming and boating. A heated swimming pool is located just off the lake. Indoor athletics take place in our large gymnasium, which includes a gymnastics floor, roller hockey and basketball courts, and a theatrical stage. Additional highlights include horseback riding facilities, a high ropes course with climbing tower and zip line, and a robust arts program featuring photography, ceramics, woodworking, crafts, and glass blowing.



MEALS & NUTRITION

Campers enjoy three nutritious buffet style meals each day in our dining hall, along with an evening snack. Camp Chateaugay is a 100 percent peanut and tree nut free camp. Dietary requests such as vegetarian, gluten free, dairy free and vegan are available upon request. Meals are more than nourishment. They are shared moments that bring our community together.





CABINS & LIVING SPACES

Campers live in comfortable, home like cabins, each housing 10 to 12 campers with 2 to 3 counsellors. Cabins include private bathrooms and showers, and every camper has personal cubby or storage space. Our living spaces are designed to feel safe, welcoming, and familiar.



HEALTH & WELLNESS

Health and wellbeing are top priorities at Camp Chateaugay. We have a full time resident doctor and three registered nurses on staff to monitor and attend to campers' medical needs. Our infirmary, known as the "Pillbox", is fully equipped to manage emergencies and isolate illness when necessary. You can feel confident knowing that your children are well cared for at all times.



TRANSPORT

We provide transportation for campers travelling from New York City, Albany, Montreal, South Florida, LA, and DMV. Campers who fly arrive in Burlington, Plattsburgh, or Montreal, where our staff meet them and escort them on the short drive to camp. Clear communication and careful supervision ensure a smooth and supported travel experience.
